

jQuery Progressive Bar Countdown Timer

Getting started

Make sure to load your jQuery and CSS documents in the head of the document.

Creating the div (timer)

If you are looking to set up a timer with a counting clock rather than a loading percentage this is how you'll set one up.

```
1. <div class="circles-container">
2.   <div id="circle-1" data-circle-dialWidth=10 data-circle-skin="yellow">
3.     <div class="loader-bg">
4.       <div class="text">00:00:00</div>
5.     </div>
6.   </div>
7. </div>
```

Creating the div (percentage)

Here's what your container will look like for a loading bar instead of a timer. Here you can change the overall size and width of the load, as well as its stopping value. It can stop at 100% or you can cut it short.

```
<div class="page">
  <div class="circles-container">
    <div class="circle-2" data-circle-maxValue="98" data-circle-counter=1000 data-circle-size="500px">
      <div class="loader-bg">
        <div class="text">0%</div>
      </div>
    </div>
  </div>
</div>
```

Setting up the function

Here you can set up the function() through jQuery.

You can adjust the `maxValue` to have the timer stop at a given value (seconds).

```
$(document).ready(function() {  
    $("#circle-1").Circlebar({  
        maxValue: 30,  
        fontSize: "14px",  
        triggerPercentage: true  
    });  
});
```

Script

The rest of this script is what you'll need for customizing your circles. If you're making a timer look at circle-1, and if you're making a loading bar, use circle-2.

```
$("#circle-1").Circlebar({
    maxValue: 20,
    fontSize: "14px",
    triggerPercentage: true
});
var t2 = new Circlebar({
    element: ".circle-2",
    maxValue: 152,
    dialWidth: 40,
    fontColor: "#777",
    fontSize: "30px",
    skin: "fire",
    type: "progress"
});
```
