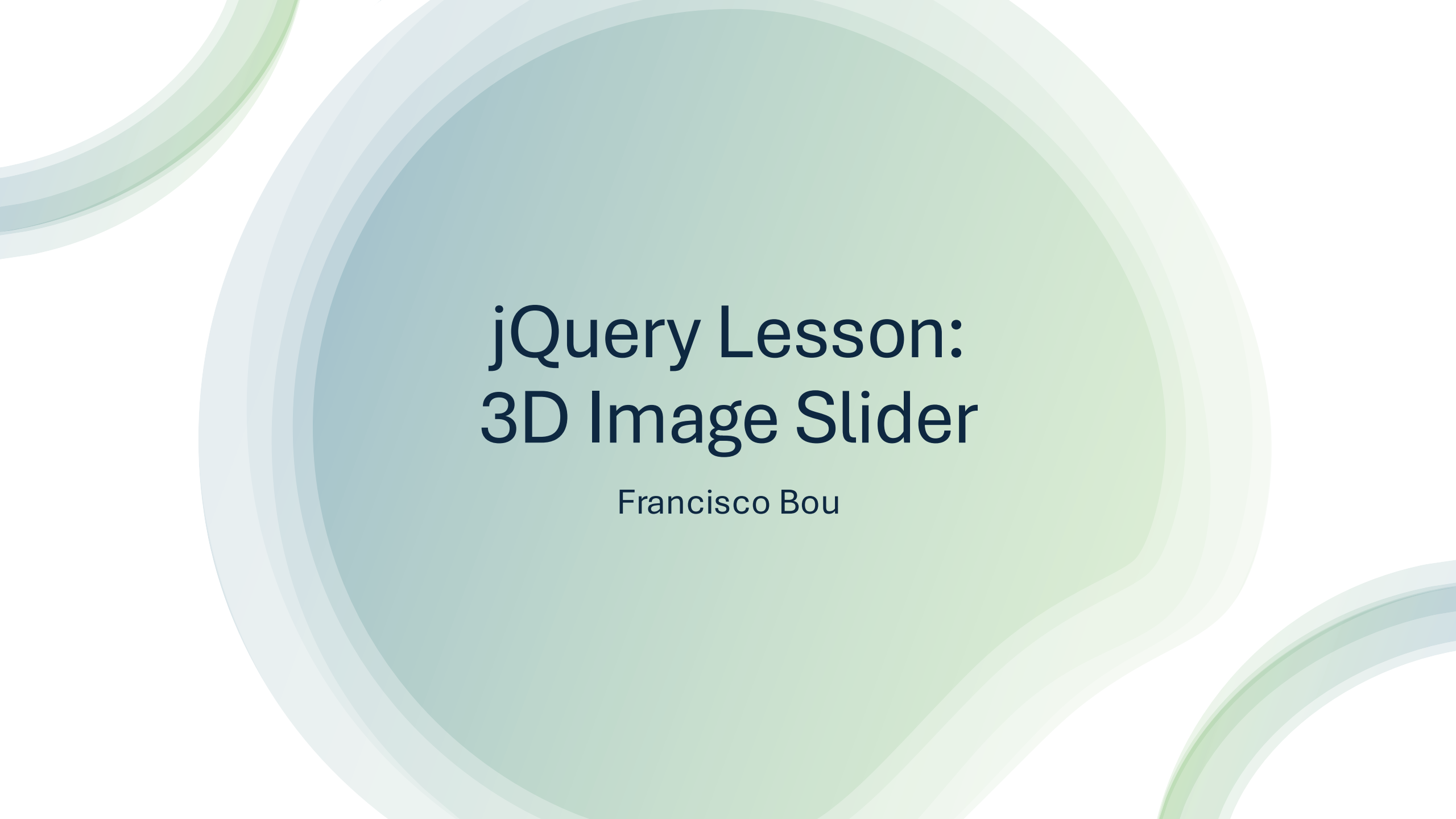
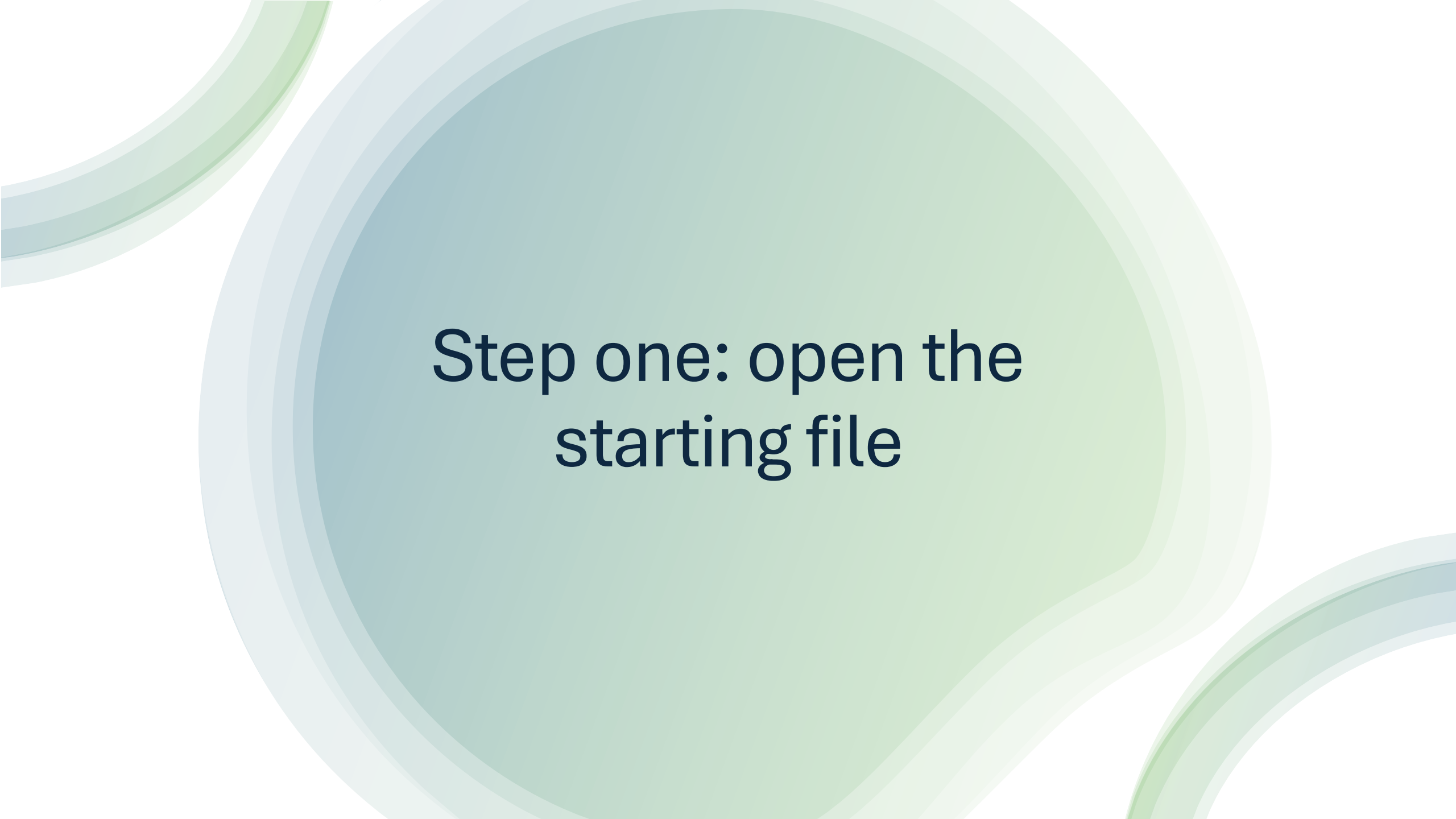




jQuery Lesson: 3D Image Slider

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Step one: open the
starting file

Link the stylesheets

- First, link the following stylesheet file to the head.

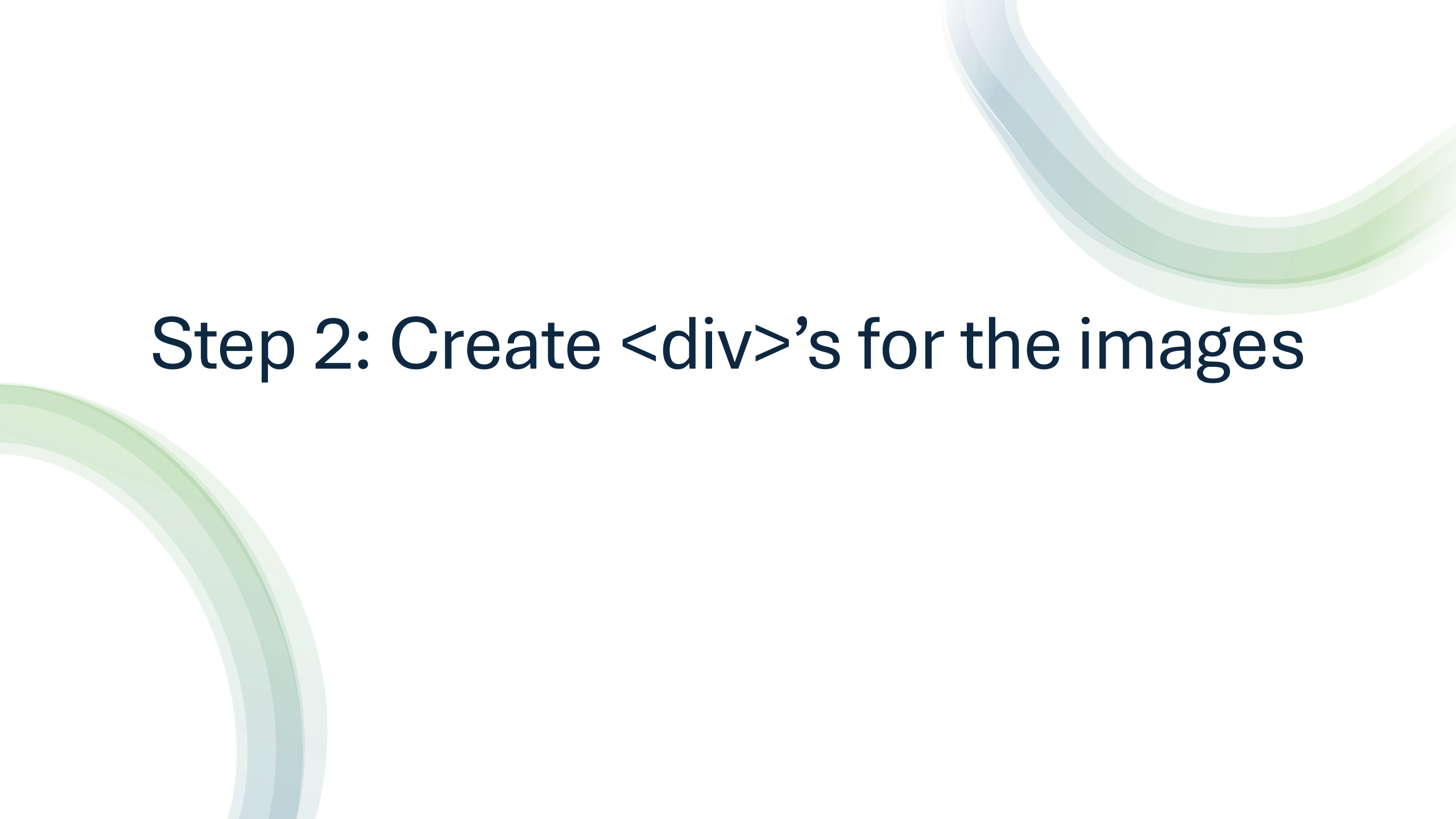
```
<link href="jquery.hislide.css" rel="stylesheet">
```

```
<link href="styles.css" rel="stylesheet">
```

Link the jQuery Plug-ins to the index file

- Add the two JavaScript files with the <script> tags to the body of your HTML.

```
<script src="jquery-3.1.1.min.js"></script>  
<script src="jquery.hislide.js"></script>
```

Step 2: Create `<div>`'s for the images

Create a div for the image area

- Add a `<div>` to the body with id `img-area` and a class of `hi-slide`.
- Add the following `<div>`:
 - div with a class `“hi-prev.”`
 - And a div with a class of `“hi-next.”`

<div class="img-area hi-slide">
```

```
<div class="hi-prev"></div>
```

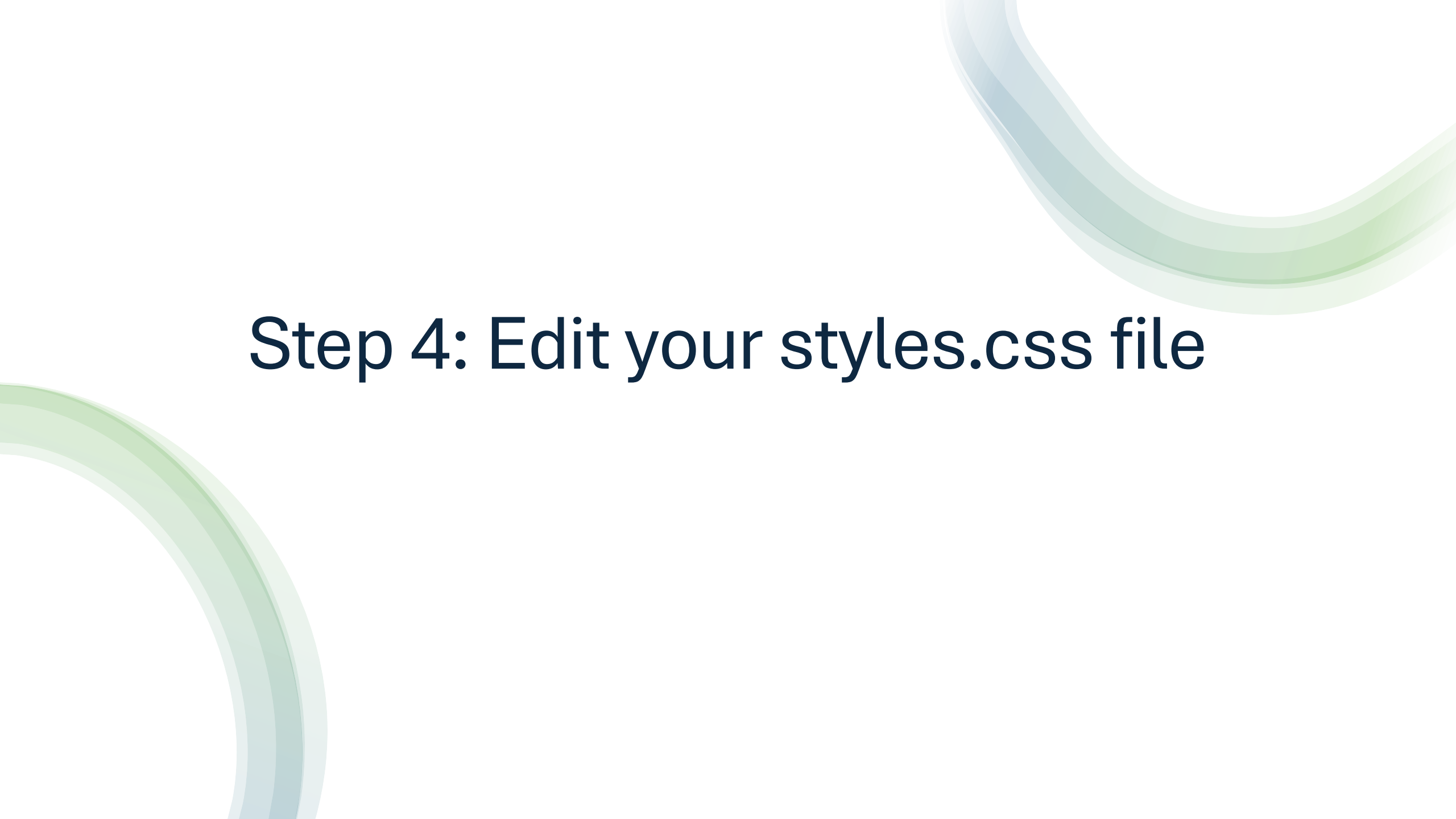

```

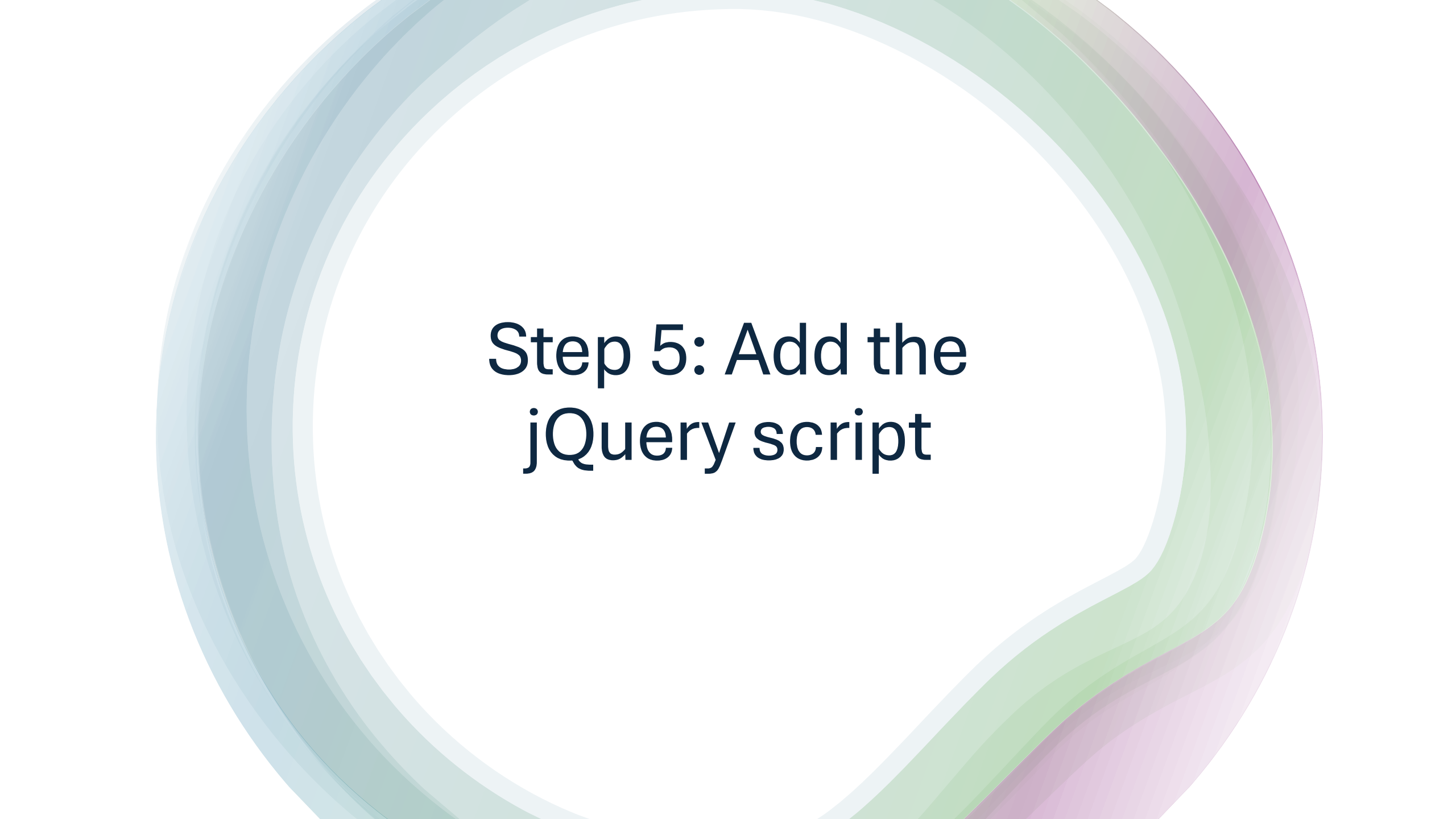

- Add the following rules:

Step 5: Add the jQuery script

Head back to the index.html

- Add the following jQuery script below the linking scripts:

```
<script>  
$($('.img-area')).hiSlide();  
</script>
```
